COVID-19 – Latest guidelines for schools

It is very important that all parents, carers and students are aware of the latest guidelines for the safe operation of our school. The full document released by the Department of Education is available at <https://education.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/advice-for-families>. Please note:

- Students should not attend school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms
- Anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms should arrange to be tested for COVID-19
- Students will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school
- Moorefield Girls will make arrangements for any student who presents at school as unwell, to be sent home
- All mobile phone numbers for parents/carers and emergency contacts must be up to date. Please inform the school if you have recently changed your number.
- Parents and non-essential visitors are not permitted to be on school grounds. Some parent meetings will occur due to the necessary nature of the matter.
- Any visitors on site will need to sign the Visitor Acknowledgement Form (available at the front office)

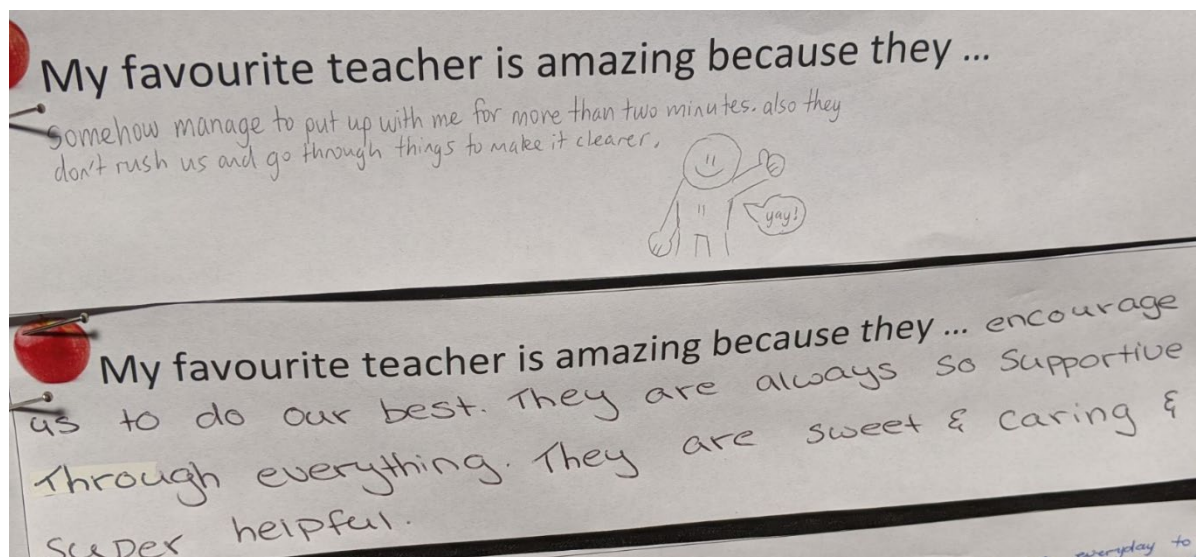
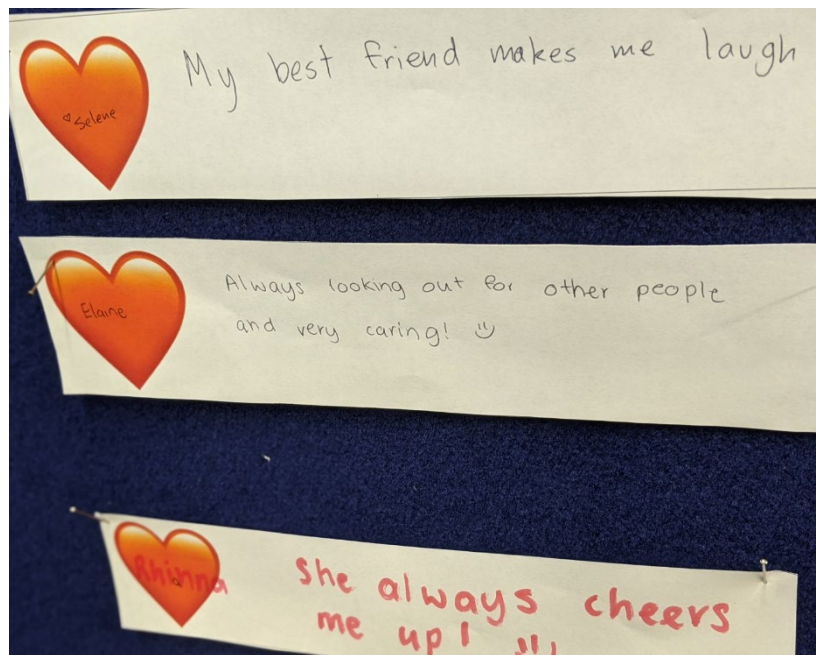
Subject Selection - 2021
