- Daily messages will be communicated via Year Group Wellbeing Teams this is very familiar for students.
- If your daughter **does not have access to a device or the internet** for online learning, please contact the school and we can discuss available options.
- There will only be minimal staff supervision at school for those students who must attend. Students at school will also learn online following the same lessons as those students at home.
  - $\circ$  The canteen will not be open. Students should bring their own food if attending.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  While at school, face masks are required for all indoor settings.
  - Students with any flu-like symptoms, or who feel unwell, should not attend school and should take a COVID test immediately. Anyone who has been off sick from school will be required to return a negative COVID test before being permitted to return to school.
- Some Year 12 students may be invited into school at specific times to work on HSC practical activities and projects. This will be arranged with their teacher.

• The Assisted School Travel Program will still be operating as normal in Week 1 for students who access taxis to and from school. Masks must be worn.

We understand the difficulties and frustrations encountered by everyone in our community at different levels during this time. School Counsellors will be available via telephone and on site throughout the week and Year Advisors will be available for students via Wellbeing Teams.
